## 1. OBJECTIVES OF THE POLICY

---

To provide a clear definition of the uniform requirements for all appointed Netball NSW State Teams (including NSW Swifts and ANL) athletes, officials (coach/assistant coach/manager) and medical staff.

## 2. OFFICIALS – COACH / ASSISTANT COACH / MANAGER

---

2.1 *Competition Uniform and Official Functions* - The following uniform must be worn by all appointed Netball NSW State Team Officials during on court events and/or official functions:

- Navy separates (including skirt, pants or dress shorts) which are to be provided by the individual at their own expense.
- Official embroidered blue dress shirt OR official polo dress shirt as provided by Netball NSW.
- Black or navy shoes that are appropriate to the tasks involved in performing within the role, which are to be provided by the individual at their own expense.

2.2 *Training Uniform* - The following uniform (as provided by Netball NSW) must be worn by all appointed Netball NSW State Team Officials during training sessions at the National Championships:

- Tracksuit or shorts (dependent on climate of the host State/Territory).
- Polo shirt.
- Socks

2.3 *Travelling* - State Team uniform requirements to be worn during travelling are to be determined in consultation with the Tour Manager.

2.4 *Important Note:*

- Denim and tracksuit pants are **NOT** to be worn by any appointed Netball NSW State Team Official when attending on court events or official functions.
- Netball NSW State Team Officials are to be dressed similarly at all times.

### 3. MEDICAL STAFF

---

- 3.1 *Competition Uniform* - To assist the medical staff in performing the necessary tasks within their role, either of the following uniform options may be worn by all appointed Netball NSW State Team medical staff during competition at the National Championships:
- i) Option 1
    - Navy separates (including skirt, pants or dress shorts) which are to be provided by the individual at their own expense.
    - Official embroidered blue dress shirt OR official polo dress shirt as provided by Netball NSW.
    - Black or navy shoes that are appropriate to the tasks involved in performing within the role, which are to be provided by the individual at their own expense.
  - ii) Option 2 (as provided by Netball NSW)
    - Tracksuit or shorts (dependent on climate of the host State/Territory).
    - Polo shirt.
    - Socks.
- 3.2 *Training Uniform* - The following uniform (as provided by Netball NSW) must be worn by all appointed Netball NSW State Team medical staff during training sessions at the National Championships:
- Tracksuit or shorts/jacket (dependent on climate of the host State/Territory).
  - Polo shirt.
  - Socks
- 3.3 *Travelling* - State Team uniform requirements to be worn during travelling are to be determined in consultation with the Tour Manager.
- 3.4 *Official Functions* - The following uniform options must be worn by all Netball NSW State Team medical staff during official functions:
- i) Option 1 (as provided by Netball NSW)
    - Tracksuit or shorts/jacket (dependent on climate of the host State/Territory).
    - Polo shirt.
    - Socks.
  - ii) Option 2
    - Navy separates (including skirt, pants or dress shorts) which are to be provided by the individual at their own expense.
    - Official embroidered sky blue dress shirt as provided by Netball NSW.
    - Appropriate black or navy shoes which are to be provided by the individual at their own expense.
- 3.5 *Important Note:*
- Denim is **NOT** to be worn by any appointed Netball NSW State Team medical staff when attending competition events or official functions.
  - Netball NSW State Team medical staff are to be dressed similarly at all times.

## 4. ATHLETES

---

- 4.1 *Competition Uniform* - The following uniform (as provided by Netball NSW) must be worn by all Netball NSW State Team athletes during competition at the National Championships:
- Official Playing Uniform
  - Tracksuit or shorts/jacket (dependent on climate of host State/Territory).
  - Polo shirt.
  - Backpack/sports bag.
  - Socks.
- 4.1.1 During competition warm up, athletes are permitted to wear any combination of the official uniform providing they are all dressed similarly within their respective teams (e.g. all players in tracksuit pants and polo shirt OR all players in playing uniform and polo shirt).
- 4.1.2 As per the Netball Australia Events Manual, in the case that uniform is supplied by Netball Australia on behalf of the event sponsor for the National Championships, athletes must wear the sponsor clothing whenever the team is together during the course of the Championships (i.e. travelling to courts, training sessions etc).
- 4.2 *Training Uniform* - The following uniform (as provided by Netball NSW) must be worn by all Netball NSW State Team athletes during training sessions both prior to and during the National Championships:
- Training singlet.
  - Training shorts/bike pants.
  - Socks
- 4.3 *Travelling* - State Team uniform requirements to be worn during travelling are to be determined in consultation with the Tour Manager.
- 4.4 *Official Functions* - The following uniform options must be worn by all Netball NSW State Team athletes during official functions:
- i) Option 1 (as provided by Netball NSW)
    - Tracksuit or shorts (dependent on climate of the host State/Territory).
    - Polo shirt.
    - Socks.
  - ii) Option 2 (if applicable)
    - Navy separates (including skirt, pants or dress shorts) which are to be provided by the individual at their own expense.
    - Official embroidered blue dress shirt as provided by Netball NSW.
    - Appropriate black or navy shoes which are to be provided by the individual at their own expense.
- 4.5 *Important Note:*
- Denim is **NOT** to be worn by any Netball NSW State Team athlete when attending competition events or official functions.
  - Netball NSW State Team athletes are to be dressed similarly at all times.
