Assessment Panel Terms of Reference

Introduction

Netball NSW is passionate about providing as many opportunities, to as many people as possible, to enjoy the sport we love. Our vision is that netball is the sport of choice for schools, community groups and individuals. With over 115,000 registered members and over 20,000 school students participating in school-based netball programs netball maintains its status as one of the most popular sports for adult participation and the most popular team sport for junior girls. However, there is still much work to be done to make netball truly inclusive, at all levels of the sport.

The Inclusive Community Grants will address barriers to participation in netball of underrepresented groups, including but not limited to:

- i) Socioeconomically disadvantaged communities;
- ii) Indigenous Australians;
- iii) Culturally and linguistically diverse (CALD) communities;
- iv) LGBTIQ people and communities;
- v) Geographically isolated communities; and
- vi) Persons with disabilities

- The Participation Coordinator – Community Engagement will be responsible to research any background or other information required by the Assessment Panel and for verifying the authenticity of the information on the proposed nominee
