Margaret Corbett OAM is a High-Performance Coach. She holds life membership of Netball NSW, is an inductee in the Netball NSW Hall of Fame and in 2019, was elevated to Netball NSW Legend status.

As a coach Margaret was passionate on the court and off it. She was an innovator, committed to excellence for herself and her athletes, this drive led the Waratah Teams she coached to unparalleled success in the Golden Boot era.

Margaret was a champion of regional athletes and was relentless in her search for the next Diamond in the rough. She never lost her strong links with community netball and recognised and supported the importance of strong foundation coaching. Margaret was dedicated to coach development, education and mentoring and was generous in sharing her wisdom and knowledge. She respected the rules of the game and always displayed positive sportsmanship.

Margaret believes a love of the game and the ability to be honest with athletes, other coaches and yourself is at the heart of success for Netball in NSW.

- A registered member of Netball NSW who is 18 years of age or older and has relevant experience with the coach.
