Netball NSW Performance and Pathways programs aim to lead the way in delivering positive experiences that challenge and inspire a drive to strive for success.

In 2022, Netball NSW will select a 17U and 19U team to represent the state at the National Netball Championships, a Metro Emerging team and Regional Emerging team to play each other in an intra-state tournament and a Sydney Netball Academy squad of 15-16 year old athletes that show the potential to progress in the Emerging Talent Pathway.

Performance and Pathways programs create an environment for athletes to realise their potential on court and grow as young women off court. These programs play an integral part in continuing the strong tradition of Netball as the number 1 female participation sport and for ensuring that NSW creates a winning culture for athletes who aspire to strive and shine.

Netball NSW is committed to value and support the Coaches, Managers and support staff that take up the exciting challenge of Performance and Pathways Netball.

A Team or Squad Manager is a vital role within performance programs. It is their organization skills that enable the program to run smoothly and a strong manager will be a catalyst in stimulating athlete growth through nurturing an inclusive, safe, honest and calm environment.

- Camp – April
- Metro V regional Championships – April

Sydney Netball Academy Manager:

- Training sessions between January – April & July - October
- Academy Camp - March
- Academy Games – April
- Academy Challenge – September
