Competition Rules

1) Staying COVID Safe

- When performing challenges participants are reminded to stay socially distant where possible and to follow all current Public Health Guidelines.

2) Entry Eligibility

- Entries will be accepted as individual classes
- There is no limit to the number of classes a School can enter however an individual student may only be represented in one class
- For Secondary Schools it is suggested that class entries could be done via Homeroom or PE classes
- Classes must be registered in order for points from completed challenges to be counted
- There is no entry close date, classes can sign up at any time throughout the competition. Although we do recommend entering within the first two weeks so you have the best chance at winning points!

3) Submissions

- There are 3 ways to submit your completed challenges
 - Via the hashtag #upforthechallengensw21 (the profile you are posting from must be set to public so we can see the submission and you must also reference your class name and/or class hashtag)
 - Via google docs: please create a folder where you can upload submissions to. Don't forget to share this folder with either our schools@netballnsw.com email OR ksapienza@netballnsw.com so we can access submissions.
 - By sending content to our schools email: schools@netballnsw.com
- Completed challenges must be submitted by 5pm on Fridays every fortnight. There is a calendar provided with a submission schedule.
- Late submissions over the weekend will be considered but will automatically lose 1 point per day late (i.e. -2 points for entries received on Sunday)
- No submissions will be accepted once the next week has begun
- Bonus challenges can be completed and submitted at any point throughout the competition
- One submission per class per challenge, unless stated otherwise on the challenge booklet
- Submission must be fully completed to be awarded the full points, if incomplete Netball NSW staff will assign points based on the criteria provided on the challenge booklet.
 - Part points may be assigned for complete challenges based on the set out criteria



- Challenges will have criteria for points provided. Submissions must adhere to these points criteria in order to be eligible to receive competition points.
- Please read the submission requirements carefully, as some challenges will state that there is more than one submission allowed.
- All challenges are optional, however the more challenges you complete the higher the possibility is to win our epic prizes!

4) Points System

- Each challenge will be assigned a points value if completed and submitted
- Netball NSW staff will determine the points value and these will be displayed clearly on the challenge booklet next to each challenge
 - If submissions do not meet the full points criteria provided, the submission will receive partial points instead for each criteria fulfilled
- Each classes points will accumulate across the challenge to determine the winner at the end
- Netball NSW staff may use their own discretion to award bonus points if a challenge is completed exceptionally well. As well as the bonus challenges, some other challenges will have bonus points attached to them for a chance at extra points.
- If needed an extra tie breaker round will be run to determine the final standings
- Quality of submissions may also affect the points awarded (i.e. no low quality videos, audio or photos)
- Some challenges may have multiple submissions needed. It is up to the teacher to choose which challenges form their class they would like to submit without exceeding the maximum limit. **Each** challenge submitted will acquire the **total points** allocated (if completed to the criteria correctly)



5) Prizes

- Netball NSW will endeavour to deliver all prizes in a timely fashion however certain barriers may impede this. If this is the case a suitable alternative will be found. There will be 6 overall winners. The top 3 from the Primary Schools Competition and the top 3 from the Secondary School competition.
