Vision and Purpose

Vision

The Hart Senior State Titles is the principal state competition for athletes across NSW aged from 15 years. Talented athletes, coaches, umpires and officials come together and enjoy the challenge of intra-state competition.

Purpose

Netball NSW together with Associations across the state will work together to:

- Deliver a representative competition for athletes throughout NSW that is recognised as a progression on the Netball NSW performance pathway.
- Deliver a competition opportunity that brings the best athletes from around NSW together to compete for their Association to crown a state champion.
- Provide an opportunity for Athletes and Umpires to come together in a fun and encouraging environment to further develop their Netball skills and potential.
- Deliver a competition format and training environment format that is accessible for athletes, coaches, umpires and officials statewide.
- Deliver a competition that has a shared purpose beyond the netball court to inspire and increase athlete growth off the court.
- Provide opportunities for coaches, umpires and officials to challenge themselves to grow and develop.
- Increase the numbers of athletes, coaches, umpires and officials staying in the sport, progressing and transitioning within the Netball NSW pathway.
- Develop technical, tactical and physical skills to provide the best opportunity for athletes to realise their potential.
- Promote and instil values of goal setting, commitment, teamwork, leadership and growth mindset.
- Provide an opportunity for athletes from all over NSW to be assessed and recognised for inclusion in Emerging Talent programs.

Competition Guidelines

Competition dates

HART Senior State Titles:

- June 2022 long weekend
- Saturday 11 June – Monday 13 June 2022

Competition venue

Opens Div.1, 17U and 15U Div. 1 & 2 - Campbelltown District Netball Association

Opens Div.2, 17U and 15U Div. 3 & 4 – Camden and District Netball Association

Please note: Due to COVID-19, the 2022 Competition venues and format will be under regular review. Netball NSW will endeavour to provide any updates to the 2022 venues as information becomes available.

Competition entry fee

\$340.00 (inc. GST) per team.

Minimum age

The minimum age to be eligible to compete in the Senior State Titles is turning 15 years in the year of play.

Team entries

- Associations may enter one (1) team only into each age category of the Senior State Titles, being Opens, 17U and 15U.
- Male Divisions will be offered at the 2022 Senior State Titles

Competition format

- Each age category will have up to four (4) Divisions only.
- All minor round matches to be a minimum of two (2) x twelve (12) minute halves, with a minimum of a two (2) minute half time break.
- All teams in a division will play each other a minimum of once in minor rounds.

Coaches

- Head Coaches must hold a current Development Coaching Accreditation.
- Assistant Coaches must hold a current Foundation Coaching Accreditation.

Umpires

All umpires officiating at the Senior State Titles must hold at a minimum a current National C umpiring accreditation.
