Vision

The Hart Junior State Titles is the principal state competition for athletes aged from 12 - 14 across NSW. Athletes, coaches, umpires and officials join together for a foundation netball representative sport experience that establishes a love for the game.

Purpose

Netball NSW together with Associations across the state will work together to:

- Deliver a representative competition for athletes throughout NSW that is recognised as a progression on the Netball NSW performance pathway.
- Deliver a competition opportunity that brings the athletes from around NSW together to compete for their Association to crown a state champion.
- Provide an opportunity for athletes and umpires to come together in a fun and encouraging environment to further develop their Netball skills and potential.
- Deliver a competition format and training environment format that is accessible for athletes, coaches, umpires and officials statewide.
- Create a sense of belonging to an Association community that will result in commitment and loyalty.
- Provide opportunities for coaches, managers, and support staff to grow and develop.
- Introduce junior athletes to the foundations of fundamental movement and core technical skills that will provide a platform to progress.
- Deliver a positive first experience so that athletes stay in the sport to experience the long-term physical, psychological and social benefits of our sport.
- Increase the numbers of athletes, coaches, umpires and officials staying in the sport, progressing and transitioning within the Netball NSW pathway.
- Promote a sports culture where winning matters but development matters more.
- Deliver a competition where every player matters.
