Competition Format

Summer Series dates

Round 1: week commencing, 9 October 2023
Round 2: week commencing, 16 October 2023
Round 3: week commencing, 23 October 2023
Round 4: week commencing, 30 October 2023
Round 5: week commencing, 6 November 2023
Round 6: week commencing, 13 November 2023
Round 7: week commencing, 20 November 2023
Finals: week commencing, 27 November 2023

Summer Series format

- Summer Series will be played across 7 minor rounds +1 week of finals / 8 weeks.
- All teams will play each team in their division once, during minor rounds.
- A finals series will be played in week 8 to determine, the Winner and Runner up and final placings in each division.

Ladder position 1 v Ladder Position 2 – Grand Final match, determines Winner and Runner up

Ladder position 3 v Ladder Position 4 – Play-off, determines 3rd and 4th place

Ladder position 5 v Ladder Position 6 – Play-off, determines 5th and 6th place

Ladder position 7 v Ladder Position 8 – Play-off, determines 7th and 8th place

- All matches will be centrally timed.
- Matches will be played at 7:00pm and 8:30pm, due to court allocations timeslots may not always alternate each week.

Opens Divisions

- 3 x Divisions of Opens teams
- 8 teams per division
- Minimum age – turning 15 years in the year of play
- Division 1, 2 & 3 - Thursday night

17U Divisions

- 3 x Divisions of 17U
- 8 teams per division
- Minimum age – turning 15 years in the year of play
- 17U Division 1, 2 & 3 – Tuesday night

Key Competition Rule updates

As in 2022, the 2-point shot will continue along with Rolling Subs. Further details of Key Competition Rule updates are outlined below.

2-point Super Shot

- Goals shot by the Goal Attack and/or Goal Shooter in their designated 1.9m zone inside the shooting circle will be worth two points.
- A 2-point shot can be awarded at any time during the entire match.

Rolling substitutions

- In addition to standard substitutions during intervals and stoppages, Teams will be allowed to make rolling substitutions during play.
- Refer to clause 4.3 of the Competition Rules for further rules of rolling substitutions.

Replacement Players

- To provide flexibility to teams, in 2023 a replacement player rule will be introduced to the Summer Series Competition. Further details will be outlined in the final rule document to be published 18 July 2023.
