
- \* Full access = access to Association only







# Before you start, these are some of the details you will need. Please check with your Association Executive

- What competitions are you delivering in 2026
  - Eg, Junior/Senior Comp and Woolworths NetSetGo
- Start and End date of these competitions, including finals
- Any exemption dates (school holidays) that you are not playing
- Open date for Registrations
- Soft close date for registrations



Recommendation

Open your Registrations on 1 December 2025.

# Recommendation



Average out the Assoc fee over Junior/Senior/Inters, so everyone pays the same association fee.

If you are a club or association delivering either a Net Program or registering teams in a Set or Go competition, you are required to register as a Woolworths NetSetGo centre with Netball Australia. A new registration is required EACH year.

## Guidelines for Woolworths NetSetGo from Netball Australia.







Set and Go could look like training on a weeknight, and modified games on a Saturday. Scoring and ladders are **discouraged** for both Set and Go.



## **NNSW Recommendations**

The majority of our 10 yr olds register and play in a junior competition. We recognise that this is suitable for experienced 10 yr olds, hence we have our Junior membership fee set for 10-17 yr olds.

Whilst experienced 10 yr olds might be ready for junior netball, we also recognise that some 10 yr olds new to netball might be better suited in a Set/Go modified competition. **Flexibility is the key.** 



## Recommendation



In smaller associations where numbers need to combine, we encourage a Net/Set combined skills program and a Set/Go combined modified competition, before joining 10s in junior netball.



## Recommendation



We encourage admins to set age restrictions in PlayHQ for your NetSetGo format competition as either 4-9 years OR 4-10 years dependant on where 10 yr olds play in your association.

Please try to make it clear to parents of 10 yr olds, which comp they should be registering to, to prevent Participant Packs being sent to 10 yr olds (who should be in the junior competition) by mistake.

Whilst we encourage flexibility, we also recognise by setting age restrictions in PlayHQ these may need to be adjusted in a case by case situation to allow for the flexibility when registering.

Once NSG registration is complete, the automated system for pack distribution moves through order processing and fulfillment very quickly. Which means changes to and refunds of pack orders are typically not possible.

We hope this suggestion alleviates problems with players registering to the incorrect competition.



# Reminder: regarding the Woolworths NetSetGo Player Pack

**ONLY** those players registering into a Woolworths NetSetGo Competition – with the PlayHQ *format* selected as NetSetGo will receive a Player Pack.

**Double check** the settings in all Woolworths NetSetGo tiles have the Format selected as NetSetGo. If this is anything else, players will **not** receive player packs.

You **cannot** change the format of a competition once you have set up season/dates / registration etc.



## Association NetSetGo vs Club NetSetGo

For Clubs to be able to operate a Net Skills tier:

The Association creates a Net competition tile and invites their Clubs.

If the Association wishes to also offer the Net Skills tier:

• The association can use the same competition tile to invite their participants via the "Participant to Season" registration form.


You will need to set up 2 Competition Tiles. If possible, please setup using the following naming convention.

- 1b. Woolworths NetSetGo Set & Go Competitions.







# For NON NetSetGo competitions, recommended format is Junior or Junior and Senior.








# **Association Competition Set Up**






If you can't see your previous competitions, they may be filtered / hidden. Use the completed filter to show all tiles when you are creating a new season.



# Enter Age Restrictions to prevent incorrect registrations.

From = 1<sup>st</sup> Jan of the oldest year group To = 31<sup>st</sup> Dec of the youngest year group.

EG: this will only accept kids turning 6 and 5 in 2026




# Age Groups Set Up – Association Level ONLY (optional)

This can be used to assist clubs see how many kids in specific age groups have registered to a competition.

This does NOT restrict anyone from registering, or from being allocated to a team. It is a helpful indicator for large clubs or associations to check how many players are in each age group.

# Age Groups Set Up cont'd

This is useful for clubs to easily see what age groups their registrations fall into.

Age groups can be combined (eg multiple years of birth for Inters / Cadets ).




Now your season has been created you will need to create **Registration Forms**. Please note there are 3 tabs.

**Association** – use this only if the Association is taking registrations directly.

**Club** – use this if Associations are inviting clubs to a competition and registrations are taken by clubs.

**Custom Fields** – you can create any specific question here to appear on Association or Club registration forms.








In some instances, **both** the Association and Clubs take registrations, you will need to set up forms in both tabs.

- Most traditional winter comps will use Participant to Season Forms ONLY (where admins put players in teams).
- Social / Term by Term / Spring Comps where TEAMS enter, rather than individuals, will use Team to Season AND Participant to Team Forms.





# Association ONLY – inviting clubs to the competition and setting up CLUB management settings








Invite Clubs – from previous season or manually choose from drop down.

Note: you can invite ANY club in the system (check Assoc comp rules)

Invited clubs appear below. Once they accept, that is also noted.

Edit Roles – Recommend ALL ROLES (see later slides on Non Players).








Enter Dates – that Clubs can enter teams into the competition.

**Note:** if you wish to toggle on permission to edit team names after team allocation end date.

**Player points** – refers to giving individual players points to assist with grading.





# Clubs Now action the Invite to the Competition


Once a Club receives the invite, Club administrators will need to select the Competition main menu and then the Invitations tab.

A blue notification will appear next to the Invitations tab when an invite has been received and is pending action.


The Invitations page displays pending invites to be accepted or declined, as well as previously accepted invites. Use the Accept or Decline button to choose the appropriate action.







# After responding to the invite, the club will return to the My Competitions tab.



To begin, select Competitions from the main menu, choose the relevant competition, then click on the Registration tab followed by the Forms sub-tab. Under the Participant to Club section, you can either create a new form by choosing Set up Form or edit the existing one by clicking the button Manage.



# Participant to Season Form / Participant to Club Form

Participants will register via rego link, Administrator will allocate players into teams.

# Team to Season Form (Association Level only)

Team Managers will register team to the Competition; a unique team link is provided to pass on to team members to register directly to the team. (participant to Team form must also be set up)


# Participant to Team Form / Participant to Club Team Form

Participants will register via UNIQUE team rego link, automatically allocating them into that team, removing the requirement of Administrators to allocate players.

Note: Administrators can manually reallocate players if required.

Click Set up form and enter details. Or click **Manage** to edit an existing form.

Edit **Roles** you wish to accept through registration. Enter Dates you wish to accept registrations Age Limit from previous setting will appear here.





# **NEW** in 2026 – PlaySafe (integration with Oho)

When Non Players: Coaches, Managers, Volunteers and Officials (Umpires) register in



competitions they participate in.

Recommendation

PlayHQ, entering a Working With Children Check (WWCC) is mandatory \*. A verification of this WWCC is performed automatically via Oho's

integration with PlayHQ. Replacing hours of Admin to perform this task!


WWCC verification status will be visible in the Club / Association Dashboard in PlayHQ.

- Any non player under 18 years of age
- Club ONLY Umpires (Rep Umpires, Umpire Convenors and Umpire Mentors are not exempt)








Example of what participant sees when registering as a Non Player

#### **Enter Player Fees**

Associations: Enter your portion of the total membership fee ONLY.

Clubs: Enter your portion of the total membership fee ONLY.

Inherited Fees set by parent organisations are visible above. (2026 NNSW fees will be updated on 1 Dec).

Note: 1.99% PlayHQ fee is taken from any fee entered here. To gross up that amount use a 2.03% calculation.

Eg. If you wish to receive \$30 in bank account, add 2.03% to the \$30 = \$30.609, round up to \$31 chargeable to participant. Enter **\$31** as the fee.

#### **Advanced Player Fees**

If you wish to charge different fees for different ages or situations, you can enter Advanced Player Fees.

#### **Auto Select Options**

These are based on age and/or gender and the system will automatically offer the correct fee amount

#### **Manual-Select Option**

These fees are based on something other than age/gender, and reliant on participants choosing the correct option (honesty system).


**Note:** You can configure either 'Auto-Select' fees or 'Manual-Select' fees, but **not** both.



### Advanced Player Fees cont'd

Enter the Basic fee, as the most expensive fee. The system will offer the participant the lowest available.

Enter 31/12/2026 as Calculate player 'as at date'



#### **Auto Select Options**

When the "Auto-Select" option is chosen, you will need to enter the date to calculate the participant's age, age range, gender and the fee to be charged. If a participant meets the criteria for an "Auto-Select" fee, they will be charged that fee instead of the standard fee. If a participant qualifies for multiple fees, they will be charged the lowest applicable amount.

Note: If you accept mixed genders to your competition, ensure Gender is selected as ALL



#### **Manual Select Options**

When setting manual fees, each option must have a name and an amount to save the form. Click the "+ Add option" to add more options, or use the trash can icon to delete a fee.







#### **Enter Non Player Role Fees**



#### Recommendation

To keep Non Player fees at \$0 to encourage all Coaches, Managers, Umpires (officials) and Volunteers to register.

If all your non players are registering, their WWCC are being verified, reducing administrator's workload to do this manually.


This will also assist Coaches and Manager to turn on Management Access if you choose to use E-Scoring for your competitions.

Products can be created on the registration form itself during configuration or selected from previously added merchandise, fundraisers, and memberships.








#### **Custom Questions / Fields**

Custom questions can be created to capture additional participant information during the registration, these can be rolled over from previous season, or created via the Custom Question Field, then added to the registration form.

Coach/Manager – have visibility of availability.




#### Follow your favourite clubs
