

2026 Netball NSW All Abilities State Challenge

Taking place on the weekend of the HART Senior State Titles

Venue and Dates

- Monday, 8 June 2026
- Penrith District Netball Association
- NNSW Venue Contact – Georgia Calderwood
- Georgia will be available within the All Abilities zone all day.

Competition Structure

- All teams will play each other once.
- Team on top of ladder at the end of the rounds will be announced as the winner of the All-Abilities State Challenge

Male players

- Association teams that have male players participating are only permitted to have up to three (3) male players on court at any one time during a match, and can only have one (1) male playing in the following groupings of positions at any one time:
 - GS and GA;
 - WA, C and WD; and
 - GD and GK.
- It should be noted that there is no mixed division, all female teams will play against teams with male participants

Fixtures and results

- Fixtures will be uploaded to the PlayHQ platform
- Results and ladders will be available to view on the PlayHQ website and/or app throughout the competition.

Scoring

- All matches will be centrally timed.
- One scorer p/team to be provided.

Umpires

- Teams should provide their own umpire, who has experience officiating All Abilities competition
- They will umpire on the alternate court to their own team.

Awards and Presentation

- A presentation for teams will take place following the completion of all matches and once results have been tallied and ladder positions determined.
- A trophy will be presented to the winning and runners up team in each Division.
- Medals will be presented to the participants of the winners and runners up teams.

All Abilities – Athlete zone

- An All Abilities zone, where teams can set up for the day, will be available.
- Netball NSW will provide a shared tent space for use by all teams.
- Please see below map – please reference the blue All Abilities zone on the map.

Transport

- An Athlete drop off zone will be allocated within proximity to the All Abilities zone.

- Matches: 2 x 12-minute halves + 2 min half time + 4 minutes between rounds = 30 minutes
